### Profile:

- **Evangelist:** The CYA Director will be deeply motivated by and passionate about people meeting Christ and getting connected into the Body of Christ.
- **Connector/Organizer:** The CYA Director will be highly a relational and organized individual. The CYA director will naturally foster connection within diverse people groups and create gatherings in which those who are new to Tempe and Grace will be able to find community through Life Groups.
- **Innovator:** The CYA director will innovatively connect those who are not connected to the body of Christ. The CYA Director will do what nobody else is doing to reach those that nobody else is reaching.
- **Collaborator:** This person will be a collaborator and will work alongside campus ministries to reach the lost. The CYA director will join and seamlessly 'fit' within a staff culture that is devoted to humility, unity, passion, creativity, and excellence.

### Key Functions:

1. Create a strategy to mobilize Grace's college students to reach ASU initially and MCC eventually.
2. Create a college gathering that predominantly serves the "connect" arm of Grace's mission.
3. Mobilize teams of older volunteers who want to engage the CYA.
4. Cast Grace's vision to college students and help them gain a perspective on how they can participate.
5. Maintain a weekly presence on college campuses.
6. Partner with existing singles and Young Adult functions by bolstering their connection to the college students and instilling them with creative energy.
7. Connect college students and young adults into both organic (mentor) and organized (Grow Classes) discipleship opportunities.
